## 2 Day Colonoscopy Prep

You are scheduled to have your procedure at:

Please have your prescription for the bowel preparation filled as directed <u>at least 72 hours</u> prior to the procedure. Follow the instructions listed below carefully to prepare for your procedure.

## Starting two days before your procedure:

- 1. If you are taking <u>PLAVIX, COUMADIN OR WARFARIN</u> stop it for 5 days before procedure.
- Take <u>CLEAR LIQUIDS ONLY</u> for 2 days before procedure please do not drink anything red or green in color and do not drink any dairy products. \*Clear Liquids consists of apple juice, white grape juice, broth, coffee, ginger ale, Gatorade, popsicles, tea, any soda, popsicles and jello.
- 3. Drink one bottle of <u>MAGNESIUM CITRATE</u> at 3pm on two days before procedure; remember you only can take clear liquids on this day or Jello-O (except for red and green).
- 4. Mix Golytely as directed and refrigerate overnight.

## Starting the day before your procedure:

- 5. On the day before procedure take <u>DULCOLAX</u> at 8am in the morning; remember you can only take clear liquids on this day as listed above.
- 6. Start drinking GOLYTE as directed at 1:00pm –drink one glass every 10 minutes until all done, IF YOU FEEL NAUSEOUS GIVE YOURSELF A BREAK for 20 30 minutes. Within 1-1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours, you should start having bowel movements. You <u>SHOULD FINISH</u> the entire container. Remember .... If your colon is not cleansed, the examination will not be useful and will need to be repeated.
- 7. Drink PLENTY of FLUIDS so that you do not get dehydrated.
- 8. **NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT** the night before your colonoscopy.
- 9. Do not take your diabetes medicines on the day of procedure.



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- 10. Take all other medications the morning of your procedure with small sips of water.
- 11. You will be given intravenous sedation for the colonoscopy. **YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO DRIVE THAT DAY!!** A responsible adult must be able to drive you to the procedure and drive you home afterwards. Bus and taxi service will not be accepted. Verification of transportation will be done; otherwise you will need to be rescheduled for the next available endoscopy day.
