## **Colonoscopy Instructions**

You are scheduled to have your procedure at:

Please have your prescription for the	bowel preparation filled as directed at least 72 hours prior to the

procedure. Follow the instructions listed below carefully to prepare for your procedure.

• NO Coumadin or Plavix for seven (5) days prior to the procedure unless otherwise advised.

## Starting the day before your procedure:

- 1. ALL DAY, ALL LIQUIDS which include: Broth, water, juices, tea, soda, and Jell-O (NOTHING RED IN COLOR and NO MILK or MILK PRODUCTS).
- If you have diabetes, PLEASE DO NOT TAKE your insulin or oral diabetic medications the morning of your procedure.
- 3. The day prior to your procedure, mix the solution (bowel prep kit) with water and refrigerate.
- 4. 5:00 PM begin drinking the bowel preparation kit. Drink one 8 oz glass every 10 minutes until the entire container is finished. Within 1-1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours, you should start having bowel movements. You **SHOULD FINISH** the entire container. Remember .... If your colon is not cleansed, the examination will not be useful and will need to be repeated.
- 5. **NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT** the night before your colonoscopy.

## The day of your procedure:

- 1. If you are diabetic. PLEASE DO NOT TAKE your morning insulin or oral diabetic medications. Bring it with you and take after your procedure is completed.
- 2. NO Coumadin or Plavix for seven (5) days prior to the procedure unless otherwise advised.
- **3.** All other medications (other than the ones listed above) may be taken as directed the morning of your procedure with little sips of water, unless told otherwise.
- 4. You will be given intravenous sedation for the colonoscopy. YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO DRIVE THAT DAY!! A responsible adult must be able to drive you to the procedure and drive you home safely. Bus and taxi service will not be accepted. Verification of transportation will be done; otherwise you will need to be rescheduled for the next available endoscopy day.
